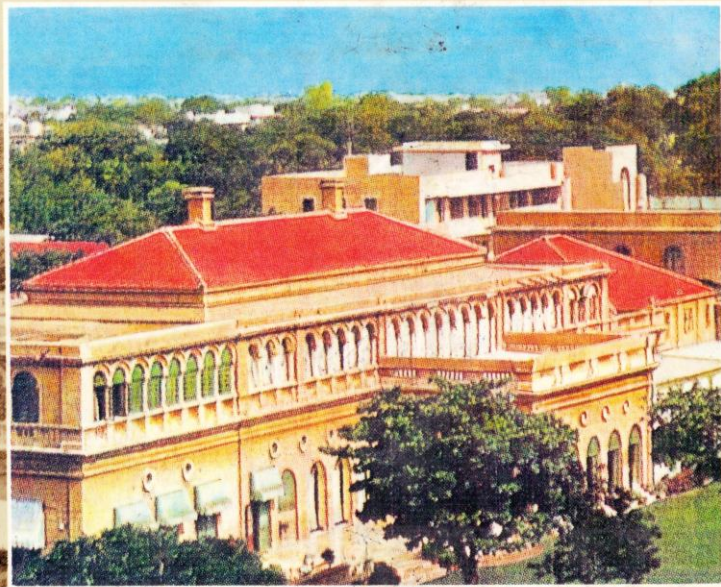

FOREWORD

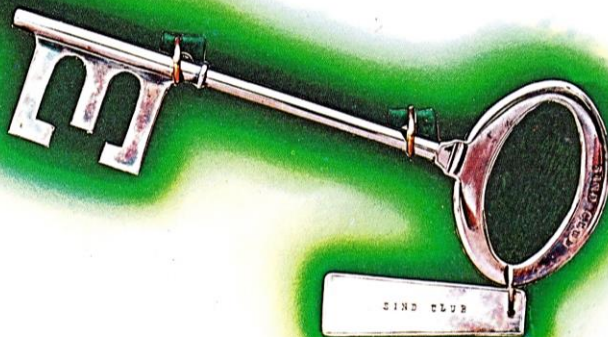
The Sind Club has remained a premier institution for over a century and has retained its unique position throughout a period that witnessed profound changes in our society, reflecting movement from being a part of the British Empire to Independence and beyond. The Sind Club is an outstanding example of an institution which has retained its values while adjusting to the inevitable transformation in social conditions.

In 1946 Mr. J. Humphrey, a member, wrote a history of the Sind Club which covered the British period, 1871-1946. Major changes have taken place since and for some time it has been felt that this history should be updated in order to record the manner in which the Sind Club became the premier club of Pakistan without compromising principles and at the same time maintaining its high standards. Mr. Azhar Karim undertook this difficult task with enthusiasm and without any consideration whatsoever for which he deserves the thanks of the Committee and the members. Messrs Karim Marlar & Associates have also given freely of their time and help and our thanks are due to them.

In publishing this book we have taken the opportunity to include the earlier work by Mr. J. Humphrey which is now out of print. Mr. J. Humphrey's work is incorporated as Part I and Mr. Azhar Karim's section is published as Part II. This book provides a historical perspective covering a period of over a century and should be of interest not only to members of the Sind Club but also to a wider audience. Most important it will help members, old and new, understand the traditions of the Sind Club and also be of guidance to future committees.
